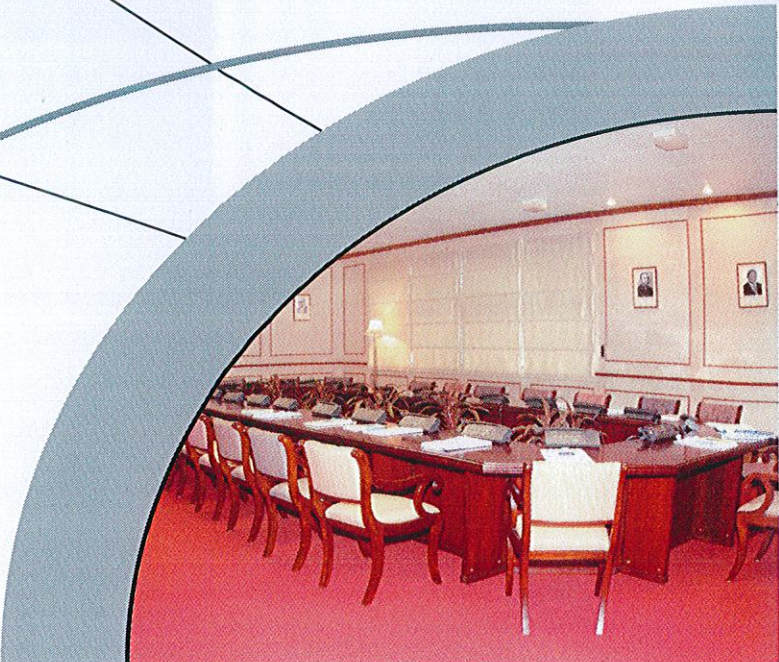

Established the first High Commission of the Maldives in Singapore with minimal resources and was instrumental in attracting Singaporean investments especially in the area of tourism to the Maldives.

#### **Permanent Representative of Maldives to UN Office in Geneva, 2006-2007**

- Actively participated in the debates for establishing the present UN Human Rights Council in Geneva. Made significant contributions to scale up donor support for the Maldives Tsunami Recovery Programme.

#### **Non-Resident Ambassador of the Maldives to the European Union, 2005 – 2007**

- Promoted the Maldives political reform agenda and led the first Parliamentary Group visit from Maldives to the European Union Parliament. I also coordinated the first European Investment Bank Loan of € 50 million to restore the tourism sector from the impact of the tsunami.

#### **High Commissioner of Maldives to the United Kingdom, 2004-2007**

- I was the first resident High Commissioner to the United Kingdom and worked closely with Commonwealth Secretariat and All Party Parliamentary Group. Developed several briefings for the meetings of the All Party Talks and led Ministerial level delegations to such meetings. In response to the 2004 Tsunami, I initiated and led the coordination for mobilising resources from the Government and NGOs in the UK. I also worked closely with OXFAM and British Red Cross to facilitate tsunami rehabilitation programmes in the Maldives.

#### **Minister, Ministry of Tourism, Government of Maldives, 1998 – 2004**

- Established a policy framework for positioning Maldives tourism industry and developed strategies for sustainable development of the tourism sector. Contributed significantly to the formulation of the First Maldives Tourism Promotion Plan in order to strengthen the Maldives as an exclusive destination. During this period the industry was threatened by the fall in global travel following the September 11th terrorist attack, SARS epidemic in East Asia and the War in Middle East and under my leadership, efforts were made to work closely with the private sector and the international community to make speedy recoveries in tourist arrivals and receipts. In 2003, the country was opened to the Chinese tourist market by enlisting Maldives into the Approved Destination Status by the Chinese Authorities.

#### **Minister, Ministry of Fisheries & Agriculture, 1993 -1998**

- Developed sustainable policies in fisheries and successfully established a ban on catching turtles in the Maldives. Established the Maldives Industrial Fisheries Company (MIFCO) and implemented the World Bank funded cold storage Facility at Koodoo island in Gaaf Alif Atoll.

#### **Director of Statistical Services, National Planning Agency, 1980-91**

- During this period I was able to support the establishment of the National Planning Agency. I headed the Statistics Department and I was able to lead the first Household Income and Expenditure Survey in the Maldives in 1981. In addition, a full scale modern national census was carried out in the country in 1985 subsequently electronic data processing of Census was introduced to the Maldives.

## AHMED LATHEEF – A BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE



Ambassador Ahmed Latheef began his Foreign Service career in 1981 as an Assistant Undersecretary at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He completed Foreign Service training in India with the Indian Foreign Service (IFS) Officers in 1982 and had further education and training in Berlin, Germany in 1989.

His career in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, since 1983 was largely in the area of bilateral and multilateral cooperation, more particularly dealing with South Asian regional cooperation. Since the formative days of South Asian regional cooperation, he worked in the SAARC Division, and had attended all major SAARC meetings during 1985 to 1997. He was a prominent member of the Organizing Committee of the Fifth SAARC Summit held in Male' in 1990 and played an equally important role during the Ninth SAARC Summit held in Male' in 1997 in his capacity as the Director from Maldives at the SAARC Secretariat. He also attended meetings of the UN, Non-Aligned Movement and the Commonwealth.

Ambassador Latheef served at the SAARC Secretariat in Kathmandu, Nepal from 1993 to 1997 as the Director from the Maldives, and after his return to Maldives he headed the Department of External Resources of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from 1997 to 2003 as the Director-General of External Resources. During this period he was responsible for mobilizing and coordinating all bilateral assistance to the Maldives and multilateral assistance from UN agencies. Ambassador Latheef also worked at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as Director-General, Foreign Relations from 2003-2004.

Ambassador Latheef had held the post of Alternate Governor from Maldives to the Islamic Development Bank (IDB) from 1998 to 2003 during which period he had attended all the Annual General Meetings of the Board of Governors of the Bank.

Ambassador Latheef had played a significant and pioneering role in setting up the first resident mission of Maldives in India when he was posted as the Deputy High Commissioner of Maldives from November 2004 to August 2007. During this period he had contributed significantly to consolidate the close and friendly relations between India and the Maldives.

After completing his three-year term in New Delhi, Ambassador Latheef moved to China in 2007 to open the Maldivian Embassy in Beijing and served as the first Ambassador of his

country in Beijing for five years. It was largely due to Ambassador Lateef's foresight and tireless efforts during this period that Chinese tourist arrivals in the Maldives reached the top of the list, outnumbering the traditionally strong European visitors. During his stewardship Ambassador Latheef helped further strengthen the close relations between the two countries. In the field of sports, Ambassador Latheef was popularly acknowledged as the "Ping Pong Ambassador" in China for his dynamic role in promoting ping pong diplomacy, through the annual Diplomats Table Tennis Tournament; a tournament that was well participated by the diplomatic community for four years.

Ambassador Latheef returned to Male' after completing his term of office in February 2012. Since then he has been promoting sports in the Maldives as the President of the Table Tennis Association of Maldives from 2012- 2016 and as the Vice President of the Maldives Olympic Committee, a post to which he was elected in 2017 for a four-year term. He is also the current Regional Vice President of the Asian Table Tennis Union (ATTU).

On 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018, upon the recommendation of President-elect, Hon. Ibrahim Mohamed Solih, Ambassador Latheef was appointed as the Director-General of Transition, charged with the responsibility of establishing the Office of the President-elect and ensuring the smooth functioning of the transition process prior to the inauguration of the President on 17 November 2018.

Ambassador Latheef continues to be an avid sportsman, who as a young man, was selected for the first ever Maldives Table Tennis team that represented the country in an international tournament in 1973 in Peking, PRC. Between 1973 and 1981, Latheef played for his country at a number of international tournaments, including those in China, La Reunion, Indonesia and Sri Lanka, in many instances as the captain of his team. He was the captain of the team that won the Bronze medal at the First Indian Ocean Island Games in 1979, the first table tennis medal for the country. He also won three national singles titles and several doubles titles during his illustrious career as a national TT player. At present he is active as a Veteran player involved in promoting the sport at the national and regional level.

In addition to being a TT player, Latheef is also a talented tennis player, and holds the distinction of being the first Maldivian to win an international tennis trophy by winning the All Nepal Veterans Tennis Championship in 1996. He is also a gifted cricketer who has represented his country in the 1980s.

Ambassador Latheef is married to Fazeena Ahmed Didi and has two children (Mifzal Ahmed and Mizna Ahmed) and three grandsons (Neil Ali Faiz, Zen Ali Faiz, and Lukey Mifzal Ahmed)


