**Ambassador-at-Large of the Republic of Maldives**

**BIO NOTE**

Ambassador Hameed is a veteran diplomat with seventeen years of experience in the Maldives Foreign Service. In May 1991 he was appointed as the Chief of Protocol at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; a post he held for fifteen years and through which he raised to be one of the most recognized figures in diplomatic circles. During his tenure Ambassador Hameed was instrumental in bringing dramatic changes to the Foreign Service including its streamlining and reorganization to a professional cadre. He used his knowledge and experience in management to institutionalize best practices and standards within the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

In December 2006, he was appointed as the Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs and subsequently in August 2008, he was promoted to the State Minister of Foreign Affairs. He held the post until his resignation from the Government in November 2008. Under his leadership the Maldives has successfully participated in meetings of the United Nations General Assembly, the Commonwealth, the Non-Aligned Movement, the Organization of Islamic Countries (OIC) and the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC).

Prior to his appointment at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Ambassador Hameed served in the transport sector. With his academic background in international shipping and maritime affairs, received from the World Maritime University (WMU) in Malmo, Sweden, he started his early career in 1973 at the state-owned Maldives Shipping Limited (MSL). From 1975, Hameed was posted to the MSL Head Office in Bombay, India as Deputy Head of the Crew Department. He later served as the Head of the Department following which he was then seconded to Zenith Management Corporation, Greece – a sister company of MSL – as Area Representative, in 1987. In 1981, Hameed returned to the MSL Head Office in Male'.

He continued his public service in the transport sector and joined the Ministry of Transport and Shipping in 1985 where he served in many posts including, Nautical Surveyor. With his transfer to the Ministry of Atolls Administration in October 1990, Hameed was appointed as Under Secretary. Under his charge he successfully carried out national development projects including the mega project titled; The Strengthening of Atolls Administration.



With his extensive knowledge and experience Ambassador Hameed has sat on many advisory councils and boards including the Maldives Tourism Promotion Advisory Council, the National Civil Aviation Safety Committee, the National Youth Council, the Maldives Association of Tourism Industry (MATI) and the Foreign Investment Services Bureau (FISB). From July 2007 to August 2009, Hameed served as Chairman of the Bank of Maldives PLC.

Most recently in March 2012 Ambassador Hameed was appointed as Honorary Consul of the Republic of Seychelles in the Maldives and held the post until his appointment as Ambassador-at-Large.

Ambassador Hameed was appointed as Ambassador-at-Large at State Minister level by H.E. President Yameen Abdul Gayyoom on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2014. He is currently charged by the Minister of Foreign Affairs to modernize the Foreign Service and coordinate all consular relations.

The credential as Non-Resident Ambassador to the State of Kuwait was presented to Ambassador Hameed by H.E. President Yameen Abdul Gayyoom on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2014.

Ambassador Hameed received the credential as Non-Resident Ambassador to the United Arab Emirates by H.E. President Yameen Abdul Gayyoom on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2015. Further, Ambassador Hameed presented his letter of credentials to His Highness Shaikh Mohammad Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President, Prime Minister of United Arab Emirates on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2015
