As the Minister of Health, Ms. Adam has been active on WHO regional consultations and World Health Assembly 2016. Ms. Adam chaired the WHO South East Asia Regional Ministerial Roundtable on Health Workforce Reform in 2015 Timor Lest. Hosted many key WHO regional workshops in Maldives such as safeguards on maternal and infant mortality, TB consultations and formulation of dengue action plan. As health achievements and impact on the people's health under Ms Adam's leadership Maldives has received WHO certification as first SEARO country

on Malaria Free and Filariasis Free Certification. Ms. Adam has dedicated her skills, time and energy to implement President Yaameen's manifesto goals on health reform and achieved remarkable success : 166 infrastructure projects on hospital/health facilities, supported the service expansion and improvement in IGMH such as the 25 storey diagnostic centre, training of GP, MBBS doctors and specialities as well as nurses, improved service delivery in atolls by placing a gynaecologist, paediatric and anaesthetic in every atoll hospital in 2015, led the establishment of medical councils and functioning under the new health legislations, mechanism for inspection, grading and regulation of food standards, restaurants and ensuring 234 land ambulances and sea ambulance are providing service to atoll health facilities; revitalisation of public health particularly dengue awareness and control, cancer screening and registry finalisation and since August 2015 concentrated on extending blood tests and screening for Thalassaemia patients to atoll hospitals, ensured state of art medical equipments and machinery are available in atoll hospital and health facilities, mobile laboratory sample transfer and diagnosis initiated in health facilities which do not have laboratory.

Ms. Adam has raised the image of Maldives as an influential member at UN human rights council. On assumption of Ambassador post in Geneva, Ms Adam actively lobbied for Maldives to win the seat with historically highest votes (185 votes) and smallest member to the UN Human Rights council. She served as the Vice President of the UN Human Rights Council, representing the diverse and wider Asian Group members during the first term of the Maldives' membership at the Council. Apart from chairing the Human Rights Council, Ms. Adam played a leading role in negotiating and promoting human rights issues; trying to reach consensus on controversial issues ie politically sensitive on territorial borders that required extensive and delicate multilateral; negotiations such as the UPR Troikas on Palestine/Israel issues, Azerbaijan/Armenia conflict and Syrian Crisis. She also led negotiations on Human Rights Issues of importance to Organization of Islamic Conference, Human Rights and Climate Change/Environment, and Promoting Trust Fund to assist Small States and LDCs. Ms. Adam has also contributed to the effective and executive functioning of the UN HRC. She played a lead role on Economic and Political Empowerment of Women and Rights of Child. In 2013 Ms. Adam actively lobbied portraying the Maldives' priorities and achievements at the UN HRC to successfully get re-elected to the UN HRC for a second term (2014-2016). During her tenure, in 2010, serving as Maldives Ambassador to WTO Ms. Adam secured 3 years of benefits and extension of assistance to LDC countries' on graduation i.e. on Maldives' graduation from LDC on 1 January 2011. She also secured Swiss Federation grant of 3 years of funding towards the rent of Maldives Mission in Geneva.

At the UN headquarters in New York, Ms. Adam attended as member of Maldives delegation to United Nations General Assembly Sessions in 2007, 2008 and 2009. Ms. Adam also attended

several UN follow-up meetings and negotiations on climate change, consultations on Security Council reform, LDC issues, SIDS issues at ECOSOC and AOSIS negotiations for Bali , Copenhagen, Cancun, and Durban. Ms. Adam was a lead negotiator in the Maldives delegation on climate change and human rights negotiations. In 2010, as Key Note Speaker she addressed Transparency International on Climate Change finance and Accountability. She secured funding and hosted the platform of progress members of climate change in the Maldives' in 2010.

In addition to the interventions made during the UNGA, UNOG& UNFCC meetings, as a key note speaker, Ms.Adam addressed the United States of America Congressional Briefing on Developing Country of Climate Change and Adaptation Funding (Sponsored by Senate Affairs Foreign Committee convened on 20 November 2007 in Washington DC)



Biography of Zenysha Shaheed Zaki

Zenysha Shaheed Zaki is the Minister of Gender and Family of the Republic of Maldives. At the age of 31, she was sworn in as the Maldives' youngest female Cabinet Minister on 22 June 2016.

Ms Zenysha graduated from the University of Otago in New Zealand with a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Political Studies in 2006, and Masters of International Studies in 2008 on a multidisciplinary programme of International Law, History, Political Studies and Economics.

Ms Zenysha previously served as the Executive Director and Founder Member of Advocating the Rights of Children (ARC), a non-profit, non-governmental organization focusing exclusively on the promotion and protection of the rights and wellbeing of children in the Maldives. Under her leadership at ARC over a period of 7 years, a number of nation-wide public awareness campaigns and programmes were launched and continue to be carried out on important issues ranging from the prevention of child abuse; promoting social values, health and nutrition; internet safety, as well as the empowerment of the girl child. ARC also works closely with Children in Shelters, and has created a "Child Advocacy Network of Disability Organisations" (CAN DO), as a collective voice of organizations working on the rights of children with disabilities.

In 2008, Ms Zenysha joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Maldives and served as the head of various divisions of the Foreign Relations Department. During her career in the Maldivian Foreign Service, she was part of the official delegations for the 18th SAARC Summit held in Nepal in 2014, and also the 67th Session of the United Nations General Assembly which was held in New York in 2012, among others. Ms Zenysha continued to serve ARC in a voluntary capacity while at the same time pursuing her career in the Foreign Service until her resignation from her post as a Director at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, in February 2016.

Ms Zenysha also contributed her services to advance the field of sports in the Maldives. Since February 2015, she served as the Manager of the Maldives National Women's Badminton Team, which won a Bronze Medal at the Indian Ocean Island Games held in Reunion Island in August 2015. She was elected as a member of the Executive Committee of the Badminton Association of Maldives, in May 2016.

For her contributions towards the rights and wellbeing of children in the Maldives, Ms Zenysha was presented with the National Youth Award in 2012. In 2015, the President of the Maldives presented her with a National Award for her contributions towards the advancement of human rights in the Maldives, and for raising public awareness in the area of human rights.
