Mohamed Zahid is acknowledged to be one of the main pillars on which the successes achieved particularly in Noonu and Shaviyani Atolls have been built.

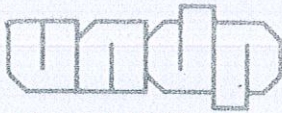

I have known Mohammad Zahid for over five years in my capacity as Senior Adviser, South Asia Poverty Alleviation Programme (SAPAP) funded by the United Nations Development Programme.

As National Project Coordinator (NPC) of the Maldives component of SAPAP, Zahid made a commitment to the Programme without which not much would have been achieved. Zahid located himself in Noonu Atoll unlike the usual practice of managing a project from Male. By remaining physically in the Atoll, at considerable hardship and inconvenience to his family, Zahid was able to establish an abiding rapport between the islanders and the Atoll administration on the one side and SAPAP on the other. He did trail blazing in getting habit of savings accepted by a large majority of islanders.

However, Zahid's biggest achievement through SAPAP was bringing about a change in the attitude and perception of island communities about their own development. 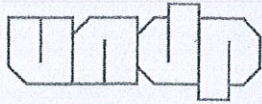
Zahid set an example of how effective Atoll development projects should be implemented.


